

STEP 1

Divide your class into small groups of 3 or 4 students, then print a copy of all of the *challenges* for each team.

STEP 2

Print a copy for each team of the document entitled "*Clues*" and cut out each card.

Make sure to keep the clue cards separate.

STEP 3

Distribute the first challenge, face down, to each team. **Note that each team will need a pair of scissors.**

STEP 4

Once the copies have been distributed, but before the students have turned over the sheet, read the following situation: To highlight the Holidays, your school has decided to hold a Candy Hunt. Each student gets one bag of candy, but the teachers have hidden them. You must find the three clues that will lead you to your bag of candy.

To get your bag of candy, you have to find out 3 things:

- The image on the bag of candy;
- The number of candies in the bag;
- Where the bag is hidden.

To do this, you must complete 3 challenges. Each time you complete a challenge, you will get a clue card. To get your bag of candy, you must have collected the three clue cards.

Now that you know what to do, you're ready for the first challenge. Starting in 3, 2, 1... go!

STEP 5

In teams, the students must complete the challenges on their sheet. Once they have completed the first challenge, they must raise their hand to have it corrected.

STEP 6

Using the **answer key**, determine if the team successfully completed the challenge. If they do not have the correct answer, they will have to repeat the exercise until they get it right. If the team has the correct answer, give them Clue #1 as well as the next challenge, which they can start immediately.

STEP 7

The game ends once all of the teams have completed the 3 challenges and collected the 3 clue cards they need to receive their bags of candies, which are hidden in the principal's office.
